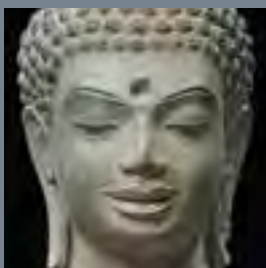

DYNAMIC DISTRICTS

Discover all things Pasadena in three inviting areas that blend the city's storied past with its exciting present.

Within Pasadena's 1.5-mile downtown core, you'll find retail areas, cobblestone courtyards, sidewalk bistros, and nightlife in three alluring shopping and entertainment districts: Old Pasadena, the Playhouse District, and South Lake Avenue.

FACT

Pasadena was named one of the top 100 places to live in the U.S. by Livability.com and Richard Florida's Martin Prosperity Institute in a study of more than 1,700 cities across the nation.

OLD PASADENA

The city's original commercial hub in the 19th century, Old Pasadena today is a bustling urban center with top-rated restaurants, boutiques, exclusive national retailers, and exciting nightlife filling its Victorian-, Mission Revival-, and Art Deco-era buildings.

The 22-block area is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and encompasses two city parks, a historic performance band shell, and the Moorish-influenced Castle Green—one of Pasadena's first grand hotels, built in 1898.

PLAYHOUSE DISTRICT

If you're looking for an eclectic mix of antique sellers, museums, bookstores, restaurants, and one-of-a-kind shops, all enhanced with culture and 1920s architecture, the Playhouse District is one place you'll want to visit. On the National Register of Historic Places, the Pasadena Playhouse—with its variety of theatrical productions—has been the cultural center of the district since 1917.

SOUTH LAKE AVENUE

A European-style tree-lined avenue, the South Lake district is flanked by a mixture of Pasadena institutions like Pie 'n Burger and Smitty's Grill, as well as brand-name stores and restaurants. Its cornerstone, Macy's department store, is a sleek, modern icon that was designed by renowned architect Welton Beckett in 1947 to resemble a luxury cruise liner. The 10-block area winds its way between Colorado and California boulevards.

Easy-to-use phone app, vital stats,
and tips for your stay in Pasadena.

Located at the base of the San Gabriel Mountains, Pasadena is 10 miles northeast of downtown Los Angeles, off the 210 and 110 freeways or via the Metro Gold Line. The warm Southern California climate and year-round sunshine make for a casual environment. If you intend to dine in an upscale restaurant, bring a sweater or jacket. Most days are mild, but it can be cool at night. If you plan to tour art museums and gardens, remember to bring comfortable shoes, sunglasses, and sunscreen. Temperatures here usually average a high of 77.2 degrees and a low of 51.3 degrees.

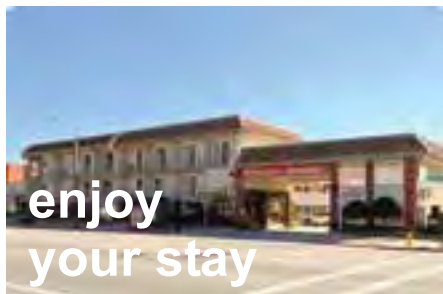

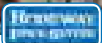

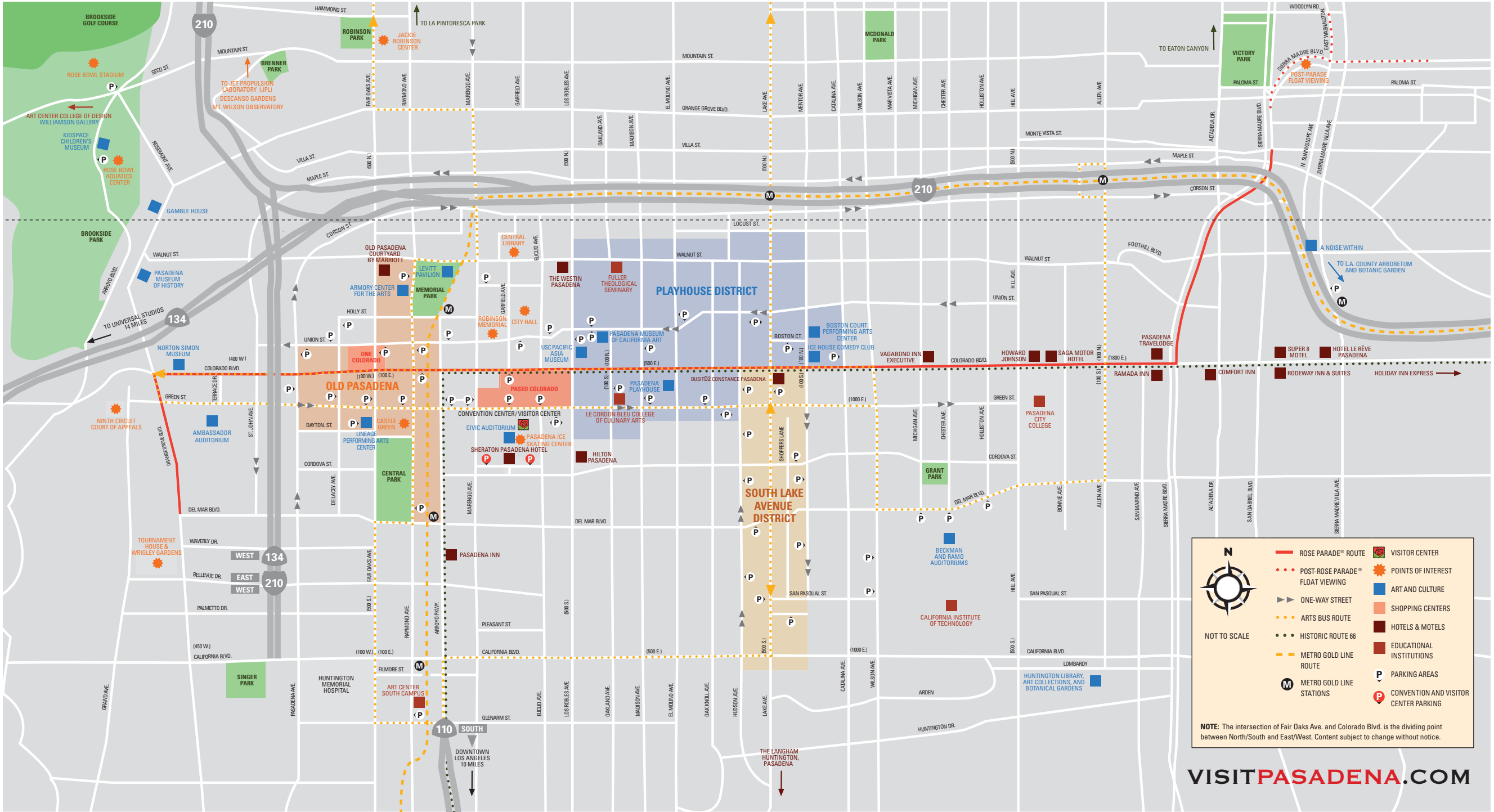
