### Program Outline

#### Thursday May 18, 2023

##### Morning:

- Presentations on ongoing or proposed climate related research – changing hydrology, soil stress and quality, productivity, water stress, and potential solutions food security e.g.: *Uzbekistan food security as a wicked problem: need for an integrated approach and rural transformation.*

#### Friday May 19, 2023

##### Morning:

- Short presentations of summaries from break out groups on Day 1
- Breakout groups to create an agenda for future hydrological and agricultural research that is tied to what we are learning about the changing climate in Central Asia  
*e.g.: Need assessment for the research agenda - IWRM- Food Security with food clusters*

##### Afternoon:

- Feedback of need assessments research agenda's
- Discussion and prioritization
- Urgent actions required

#### Saturday May 20, 2023

- Visits to agricultural institutes and linked farms that may already or will be preparing for climate change
- Visits to crucial supply chain hubs (processing of key commodities)

- Trip to Samarkand or other historic/cultural visits; meeting and talk with key stakeholders on water and agriculture.
